

REPRODUCTION & PERMISSION FEES

HISTORIC
NEW ENGLAND

All fees are determined at the discretion of Historic New England and may be changed without notice.

- Historic New England requires all requests for the use of images of materials in its collections to be made in writing via our online request form.
- Orders take approximately four weeks to fulfill from time of payment.
- Rush requests—defined as those made within two weeks of the desired delivery date—are subject to approval by Library and Archives staff. Approval depends on the condition of the materials, the complexity of the request, and staff availability.
- Payment in full is required before digital images are released.



Reproduction Fees

- **Rush Requests:** If approved, rush fees will be determined accordingly, and delivery dates cannot be guaranteed.
- **New Photography:** Fees for new photography of archival materials or objects based on size, location, and condition of materials. Contact the Library and Archives for more information.
- Orders over \$2,500 receive 20% discount

Permission Fees

- Permission fees for personal use are waived
- Permissions are granted on a one-time, one media use only. Additional language rights, additional media, or revised editions will require separate permission to publish fees.
- Permission fees granted per item requested
- Re-use rate for all uses is 50% of original cost
